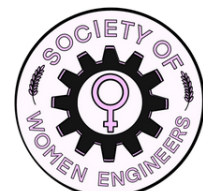

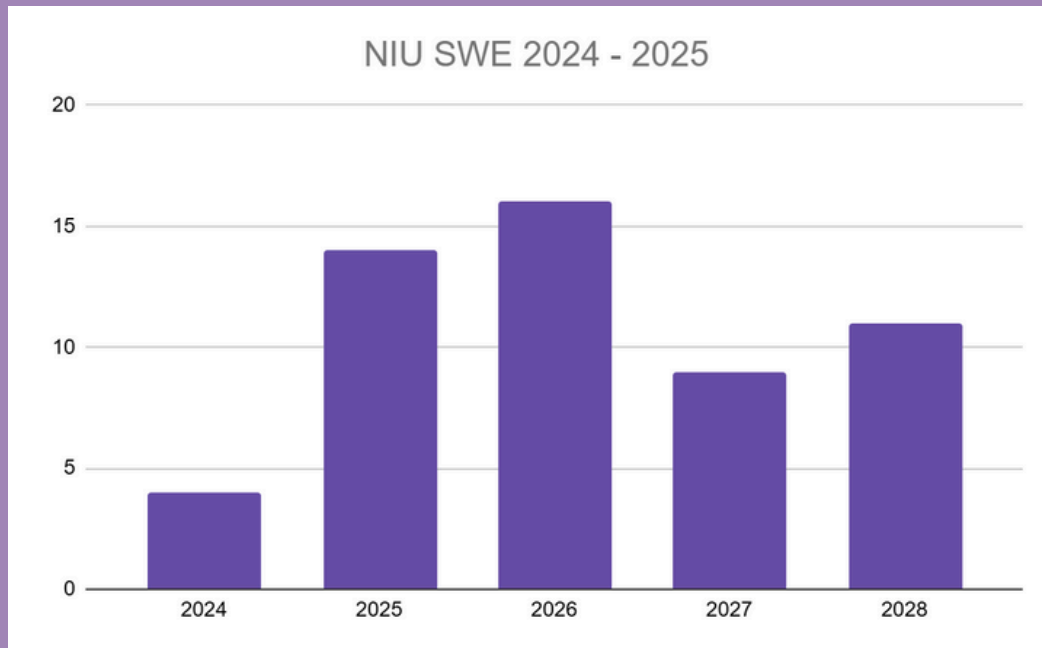

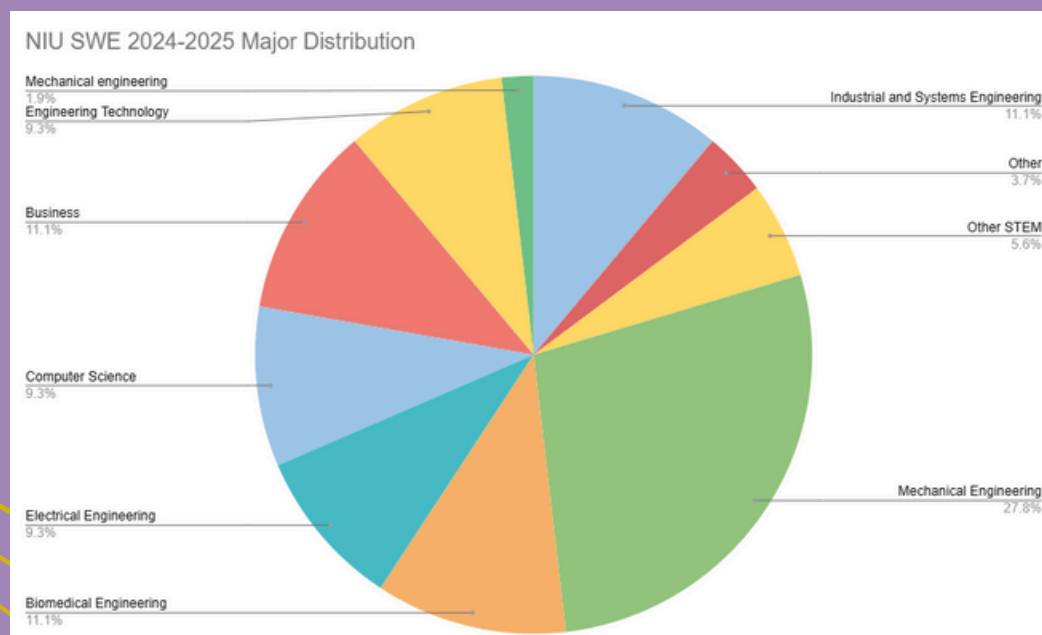


Our Members

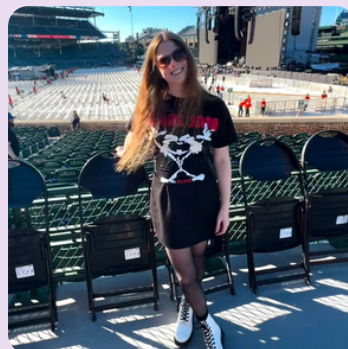

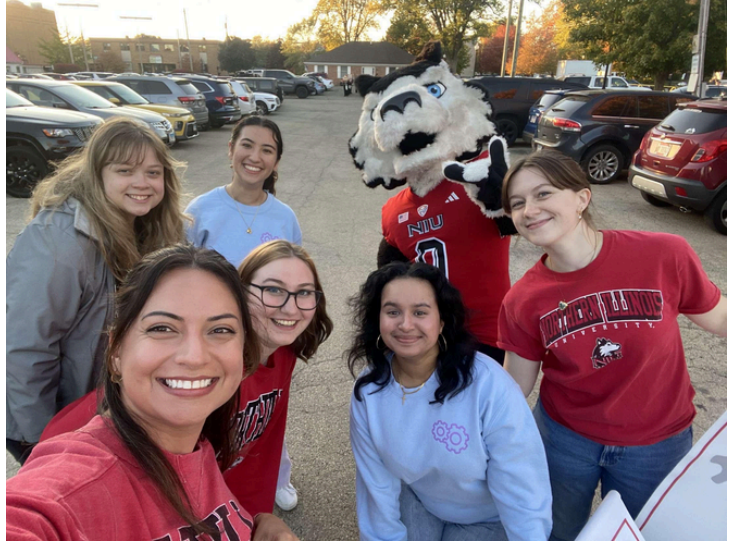

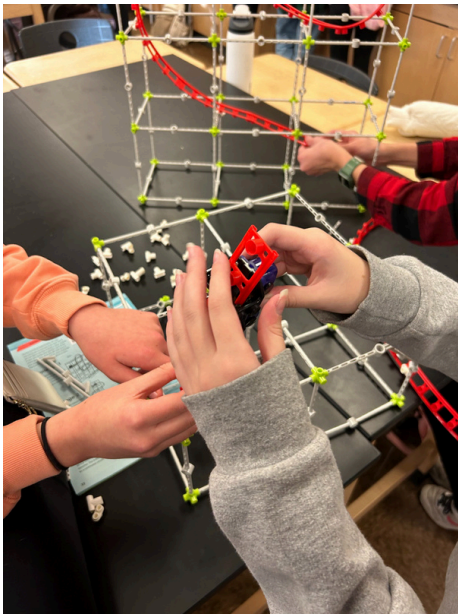
